Dr. Wolf came to the University of Kentucky (UK) in 2015 as the first Decision Support Analyst within UK Research. Since then, the role has expanded and he now serves as the Assistant Vice President for Research and Director of Research Analytics. He has more than 20 years of experience working in institutional research, effectiveness, strategic planning, and advanced analytics. He has served on state and national boards and is currently serving on the National Advisory Board for the University Benchmarking Project, a national data collection led by the National Benchmarking Institute. Dr. Wolf serves as the chair of the SRAI Data Integrity Committee and also represents SRAI on the Research Evaluation Working Group with INORMS. At UK, Dr. Wolf provides data analysis, strategic planning, advises the Vice President for Research on policy and program offerings, works collaboratively with other research administration units on campus to provide robust business intelligence and

analytic tools to faculty, staff, and leadership to improve decision making. Additionally, he serves as Chief of Staff and Manages the day-to-day operations of the Vice President's Office. He graduated with a B.S. from Berea College, a master's in Public Administration from Eastern Kentucky University, and a Ph.D. in Educational Policy Studies and Evaluation at the University of Kentucky. His personal research interests include equality issues related to gender and sexual minority populations.
