An active member of SRAI, Dr. Saha serves as Director of the Office of Grant Support and Research Professor of Medicine at Albert Einstein College of Medicine, Bronx, NY. He received a PhD from University of Surrey, Guildford, UK, a Certificate in Information Management from New York University, NYC, and completed a fellowship in International Research Management at St George's University of London School of Medicine, London, UK.

As a scientist, Dr. Saha authored or coauthored over 35 publications and 50 presentations mostly in biomedical sciences. As an administrator, Dr. Saha held many positions in academia, city government and industry. In the recent past, he worked as Chairman of IRB at NYC Department of

Health, Assistant Vice President for Research Administration and Operations at Carolinas HealthCare System, Charlotte, NC, and Vice President for Research and Operations at Resource Development Corporation at Matthews, NC. In his roles, he managed as high as 225 FTEs, and currently, manages an office that received as much as \$225 million per year in external grant funding. He also, presented over 25 seminars and workshops nationally and internationally related to research administration.

His expertise spans from funding opportunities, team building and research development to electronic research administration, intellectual properties, research compliance and research operations to efficiency and quality improvements in research administration. Grant development—mechanics of grant writing—is one of his focus areas. Recently, he helped Albert Einstein College of Medicine to increase its NIH funding 16% in two years—up \$24 million.
