

You are invited to submit a presentation for the **My Favorite Assignment (MFA)** sessions at ABC's 2025 Annual International Conference in October of this year.

**My Favorite Assignment** is ABC's celebration of teaching innovations. It is a fast-moving session with a fantastic, appreciative audience. **Presenters have 3 minutes to present** their MFA. When time is up, they will hear two things:

- a bell signaling that time is up
- thunderous applause

Some assignments take an entire semester, others just a few minutes. Some are complex, others quite simple. All My Favorite Assignment presentations showcase the presenters' love of teaching.

When submitting your MFA, please ensure the following:

**The steps involved in your assignment or task are clear.** For the presentation, the audience should have a good grasp of how the assignment is laid out. Of course, thorough details probably cannot be shared in the three-minute presentation. However, the audience should have a good idea of what happens as the assignment or task is coordinated.

**The value of your assignment or task is apparent.** You might mention a unique angle you take in teaching a particular skill, a specific application the assignment has to the real world, some feedback you have gotten from students when you have assigned the task, or other information. This description will help inform attendees why your MFA will add to their portfolio of assignments or class activities.

**MFA submissions are due no later than April 7, 2025.**
