# Nutrition Science Forum 2026

Food as Medicine: Advancing Research and Integrating Systems for Health

## April 14-15, 2026 | TBD

The Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics and the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics Foundation's third annual **Nutrition Science Forum**\* (**Forum**) will bring together leading experts in Food as Medicine, along with primary investigators of key projects to present new research findings, identify gaps across the broad range of Food as Medicine programs, and explore connections and opportunities between systems (food production, food access, and health care) to support and accelerate the health of the population.

#### **Current Situation and Need**


Food as Medicine (FAM) programs are emerging as effective strategies to improve nutrition security in patients with nutrition-related disease or risk-factors. FAM is defined by the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics (Academy) as "a philosophy where food and nutrition aids individuals through interventions that support health and wellness." FAM affirms that food and nutrition play a vital role in sustaining health, preventing disease, and serving as a therapeutic approach for those with conditions or circumstances that respond to dietary changes. Because of this, FAM programs center on connecting patients with access to nutritious foods to improve health outcomes. This is only possible with a food system that ensures healthy foods for people across all socioeconomic levels.

The Academy has identified four focus areas where FAM programs promote health and prevent disease:

- Food as preventative medicine to encourage health and well-being
- Food as medicine to improve nutrition security
- Food as medicine in disease management and treatment
- · Food as medicine to promote food safety

In July 2025, the Academy released a Food as Medicine Strategic Roadmap to guide programming and accelerate progress in leveraging FAM programs to advance public health. The four pillars of this roadmap are:

- Improve access to RDN services and medical nutrition therapy (MNT). MNT and services provided by RDNs are an essential part of successful FAM programs.
- Develop sustainable payment models. Sustainable funding for FAM programs should ensure ongoing access for participants, including reimbursement for RDN services.
- **Demonstrate effectiveness.** Demonstrating the effectiveness of FAM, including the services of RDNs, improves outcomes and lowers health care costs.
- Increase interprofessional awareness and education.
  The RDN is the integral part of the interprofessional team providing services via FAM programs.

## About the Academy and Foundation

The Academy is the world's largest organization of food and nutrition professionals, representing more than 112,000 Registered Dietitian Nutritionists (RDNs), Dietetic Technicians, Registered (NDTRs), and nutrition and dietetics students. The Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics Foundation (Foundation) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit that serves as the fundraising and grantmaking philanthropic arm of the Academy and is recognized with the highest 4-star rating by Charity Navigator, an independent evaluation service.

The Academy and Foundation support its highly regarded Research, International, and Scientific Affairs (RISA) team, which conducts retrospective synthesis data analysis, registry studies, and prospective trials both domestically and internationally, working with partners such as NIH. This data is then used to support evidence-based practice, education, and advocacy for the profession of nutrition and dietetics. The Academy has an advocacy team that has worked closely with government agencies and other organizations to improve access to nutrition care for all individuals.

#### The Forum\*

The Academy and Foundation are hosting the third year of their Nutrition Science Forum: "Food as Medicine: Advancing Research and Integrating Systems for Health," a multi-day event. During this event, primary investigators of key projects will present new and turnkey research and explore system-level connections, gaps, and potential solutions that leverage FAM programs to improve population health.

This forum will highlight the important connection between the health care system and a robust food system with community-based food programs. The event will address evidence across the broad range of FAM program types (community-based meal provision organizations (CBMOs), retail, produce prescriptions, culinary medicine), demonstrate the importance of RDNs within a variety of FAM programs, and introduce the Academy's FAM Strategic Roadmap. Agenda topics will include the linkages between agriculture and health care through FAM programs, policy roles in FAM programs, and a deep dive on FAM program types.

#### **Forum Goals**

- Present turnkey research and evidence gaps across the broad range of FAM program types (community-based meal provision organizations (CBMOs), retail, produce prescriptions, culinary medicine)
- Highlight the crucial connection between agriculture/food systems, health care, and food as medicine programs
- Identify gaps, policy needs, and opportunities for future data and research efforts as well as recommendations related to the food system and community practice for advancing FAM
- Facilitate collaborations to advance FAM programming and access, including conversations among expert attendees to garner key insights
- Introduce the Academy's FAM Strategic Roadmap and demonstrate the importance of RDNs within FAM programs

#### **Audience**
