

## **Guatemala Education Abroad Program**

## Can I participate in the Guatemala experience if I am not a student at Kansas State University?

- -Yes you will need to submit an application as a Non-degree seeking student at Kansas State University with the College of Health and Human Sciences.
- -You will then enroll in the FNDH 499 course, which allows you to participate as a student with the Guatemala experience.
- -This will also provide you coverage with the International Health Insurance

## Can I participate in the Guatemala experience as a <u>professional working in the field of dietetics?</u>

- -Yes there will be an opportunity to participate as a professional with the Guatemala experience
- -Non-student participants may include, but are not limited to, faculty leader spouses/partners, children, family members, faculty colleagues, staff members, university administrators, non-academic professionals, or community members.
- -All non-student participants must pay the full Program Fee for the study tour. Examples of program fees are: housing, meals, Guatemala NGO placement fees, Guatemala program coordinator fees, and transportation from airport to placement location. The program fee will include insurance coverage for medical emergencies. Program fees will vary depending on your chosen length of participation. Our Guatemala program coordinator can also arrange for extracurricular activities in Guatemala and will provide options and costs.
