The Academy recognizes the need for more diversity in the nutrition and dietetics profession, and it is compelled to make changes. To do this, we need your help!

One initiative we are excited to share is the work to expand funding and outreach for nutrition and dietetics programs specifically for ethnic and racial groups underrepresented. The Academy has partnered with the [National Association for](#)

Equal Opportunity in Higher Education to encourage Congress to provide \$300 million in funding for minority-serving institutions that would support allied health programs, including nutrition and dietetics. Additionally, the Academy is also requesting \$10 million for nutrition and dietetics career outreach.
