The House of Delegates (HOD) considers possible Critical Issues on a quarterly basis for the HOD to address based on submissions from the Academy's environmental scanning form. The following is the collection of all the issues members submitted through this form from August 1, 2023 through October 31, 2023 that the House reviewed during their November 2023 meeting. The House Leadership team along with delegates consider current Academy activities and initiatives when considering whether it is the right time to address a Critical Issue. If an issue is not prioritized now, it can be considered in the future. Decisions are made based on current Academy initiatives to minimize duplication of efforts and allow for the greatest impact by the work of all Academy volunteers.

Even though none of these submissions were chosen during the November 2023 HOD meeting, all of these topics are still taken into consideration during future meetings to determine priorities.
