

## Missouri REALTORS® Guidelines for In-Person Classes after COVID 19

Prior to the class, the host should send an email to registrants with a reminder to stay at home if they are not feeling well (cold or flu-like symptoms, fever and/or cough or shortness of breath). In addition, registrants should be advised to arrive 15 minutes early to allow for social distancing protocols to be used during check-in. Late arrivals will not be permitted.

- 1. Make sure classroom is clean and wiped down before and after every class (along with other frequently used surfaces such as door handles, instructor computer station, remote, etc.).
- 2. Ensure social distancing for students by placing one student to a table or six ft. from the next student (adhere to local/county recommended guidelines or stay order where the class is taking place).
- 3. The class monitor/proctor will check-in students upon arrival one at a time (the social distancing 6 ft. rule will be used) and use of the pen will be limited to the proctor). Proctor will wear mask & gloves.
- 4. Upon entering the classroom, attendees should use hand sanitizer provided by host.
- 5. Attendees should avoid shaking hands with other attendees and avoid touching any surfaces in the classroom such as light switches, cabinet and other door handles.
- 6. Do not share phones, pens or tablets or other personal property during the class.
- 7. Not required, but a face mask is *strongly encouraged and recommended* throughout the entire class time.
- 8. Reminder from the instructor at break time to maintain social distancing while leaving the classroom and to again use hand sanitizer and put mask in place before re-entering the classroom after breaks.
- 9. Public restrooms will be available with increased hygiene and 20 second handwashing and social distancing protocol strongly recommended.
- 10. Coffee and water stations will be closed for classroom events until further notice (Bottled water is permitted and should be recycled after use).

- 11. When the class is completed, the class proctor will call out the student's names one-byone and CE Certificates will be passed out directly to the individual as they exit the classroom (gloves and mask will be worn by proctor).
- 12. Attendees are advised to use hand sanitizer upon returning to their vehicle.
