## FAIR HOUSING AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL.

Federal, state, and local laws, including the REALTOR® Code of Ethics, protect people from discrimination when they are renting or buying a home, getting a mortgage, or engaging in other housing-related activities.

REALTORS® conduct their business in accordance with a strict Code of Ethics. Article 10 of the Code provides that REALTORS® shall not deny equal professional services to anyone because of Race, Color, Religion, Sex, Disability, Familial Status, National Origin, Sexual Orientation or Gender Identity.

A request that a REALTOR® act in a discriminatory manner in the sale or rental of property cannot legally or ethically be fulfilled by a REALTOR®.

## **Buyer/Tenant**

- Equal professional service from your REALTOR®.
- The opportunity to consider a broad range of house choices and neighborhoods.
- Fair and equal treatment regarding terms and conditions when renting or purchasing a home.
- Reasonable accommodations in rules, practices, and procedures for persons with disabilities.
- To be free from harassment or intimidation while exercising your fair housing rights.

## Seller/Landlord

- Required to do business with prospective purchasers or renters without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, disability, familial status, national origin, sexual orientation or gender identity.
- May not instruct a licensed real estate broker or agent to put any *limitations on the sale or rental* of property based on the above characteristics as the real estate professional is also bound by law not to discriminate.
- Cannot establish different terms or conditions in any aspect of the purchase or rental of property, based on the above characteristics.
