
Missouri REALTORS® Good Neighbor Award Winner

Missouri REALTORS® would like to congratulate Bob Robinson of Lake Ozark, MO., on being named Missouri REALTORS® 2022 Good Neighbor Award winner!

Founded by Robinson in 2014, the [Local Area Needs Initiative](#) (LANI) serves families and individuals in crisis with no geographical or political boundaries. "The uniqueness of LANI is how services are provided to the community," said Robinson. "There are no forms to complete, no waiting lists, and no red tape." This model allows LANI to be duplicated in communities throughout the state, allowing LANI to operate behind the scenes, while showcasing other community resources.

Since its inception, LANI has assisted more than 2,500 people with clothing, rent, utility bills, doctor bills, vehicle maintenance, and much more. In total, more than \$175,000 has been donated, not including countless hours and services provided by local businesses and community members.




