



Population Change: 2018 to 2019








Where Utahns live, 2019 and 2065











Urban Growth: Utah is an Urban State with Urban Issues



Total Fertility Rates







Minority Share





Female Age at First Marriage





Share of Households: Opposite Sex Married Couple with Children





Utah 10-Year Components of Population Change






Utah Population Growth by Race and Ethnicity, 2018 to 2019



U.S. Population Growth by Race and Ethnicity: 2018 to 2019




Racial and Ethnic Composition of U.S. Youth





Racial and Ethnic Composition of Utah Youth





Source Regions of Immigration to U.S.: 2017 to 2060






Utah Foreign Born Population by Region of Birth and Entry Period


Utah Population Pyramid: 1960, 2015, & 2065










Share of Households with 5+ People




Share of Households with 5+ People






Race/Ethnic Populations and COVID-19


Case Rate/ 100,000 population










Unemployment Rate, June 2020


Year-Over Percentage Change in Nonfarm Jobs, June 2020


Year-Over Percentage Change in Utah Nonfarm Jobs, June 2020






