## Neighborhood Caucus Meetings Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is a precinct Caucus meeting?**

Utah's system encourages citizens to get involved in the candidate selection process at the neighborhood level. Neighbors come together at a precinct Caucus meeting to select representatives from their neighborhood who will represent them at their respective party's convention and decide which candidates will appear on the ballot.

### **What is a "delegate"?**

A precinct delegate is someone who acts as a representative for his/her precinct or neighborhood. Delegates' main responsibility is to attend their party convention and vote on party platforms, officers, and candidates on behalf of their precinct. Statewide, the Republican Party elects approximately 3500 delegates and the Democratic Party elects about 2500 delegates.

### **Who is eligible to become a delegate?**

To be eligible, you must live within the precinct and be 18 years old by the November election. At Republican precinct Caucus meetings, you must be a registered Republican to be elected, but you can register at the meeting.

### **How do you become a delegate?**

Delegates are elected by their neighbors at the precinct Caucus meeting. The number of available delegate slots per precinct varies, but if more people are nominated than slots are available, then you will have competition and some nominees will have to be eliminated. Often in these situations, the nominees will be asked to explain why they want to be elected.

### **When is this year's precinct Caucus meeting?**

Caucus meetings for all parties will be held statewide on March 17, 2026.

### **Who can attend a precinct Caucus meeting?**

Anyone who is eligible to vote can attend a Caucus meeting for the party of his/her choice in the precinct in which he/she lives. You can also register to vote at the Caucus meeting.
