REQUIREMENTS

Scholar Attributes:

The Faculty Committee for these awards makes selections based on a broad definition of scholastic achievement. The committee considers any combination of the following criteria:

- Strong Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Academic Awards
- Research Projects
- Published Papers
- Convention Presentations
- Honors Theses

Applicant must:

- 1. Be an undergraduate student that has filed for graduation this semester.
- 2. Have an overall grade point average of 3.6 or above.
- 3. Be in good standing with the University of Florida.

Applicant Packets <u>must</u> include:

- Signed applicant information form. (see next two pages)
- Attach a one page (maximum), typed in 12 pt font, personal essay in which you explain why you should be chosen as an outstanding scholar at UF.
- Attach a document answering the following questions. (Use the numbers and headings and put in the order indicated. If a heading is not applicable, omit. Do not renumber)
 - 1. National Awards (e.g. Fulbright, NSF, etc.).
 - 2. Undergraduate Research (one sentence description and advisor's name).
 - 3. Honors Thesis (title and advisor).
 - 4. Internship—Explain with whom you worked, duration of the internship, duties and accomplishments.
 - 5. Service—List dates, service provided, and organization involved. Please be as specific as possible.
 - 6. Other awards and/or recognitions you would like to list.
 - 7. Name and telephone number of someone familiar with your academic achievements.
