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PORTS OF CALL

Ketchikan, Alaska

Built around salmon canneries and sawmills, Ketchikan was once proclaimed the Salmon Capital of the World. Its unique culture is celebrated through its renowned collection of totem poles, an accolade to Native art. Not far in the distance is the Tongass National Forest—the nation's largest—abundant with wildlife and the peaceful aura of the North Country.

Wrangell, Alaska

Situated near the mouth of the Stikine River, this small and friendly city still honors its dramatic past. Once a Tlingit Indian stronghold, then a Russian settlement, later a British trading post, and ultimately purchased by the U.S., Wrangell commemorates the changes it has endured.

Juneau, Alaska

Founded in 1880 when Joe Juneau and Richard Harris struck gold, the thriving town of Juneau offers an eclectic mix of people and pastimes. The downtown streets feature upscale shopping with a traditional twist among authentic Alaskan totems and art, while spectacular mountain scenery stuns from every angle.

Cruising the Hubbard Glacier

A journey to Alaska would not be complete without viewing the majestic Hubbard Glacier. As Alaska's longest tidewater glacier, its unrivaled proportions stretch over six miles, offering dramatic vistas of sparkling blue ice.

Haines, Alaska

Situated along the pristine shores of the Lynn Canal, America's longest and deepest fjord, is Haines, a quaint town cradled by dramatic, snow-capped mountains and a sea of lush, breathtaking wilderness—providing a natural haven for brown bears, moose and bald eagles.
