PORTS OF CALL

Kusadasi/Ephesus, Turkey

The port of Kusadasi, until recently a fishing and farming village, is today a resort town offering splendid beaches and plenty of shops. Nearby is the legendary ruined city of Ephesus, a veritable museum of Greek and Roman history.

Santorini, Greece

Famed for its spectacular sunsets, the island's distinctive crescent shape is the result of an enormous volcanic eruption thousands of years ago. Behold a panorama of indigo-domed churches, chalk-colored homes, and black-sand beaches dotted with pebbles beside azure waters.

Navplion, Greece

With its neoclassical mansions and Venetian buildings edging marble streets and imposing castles overlooking sparkling seas, Navplion is arguably one of the most romantic towns in mainland Greece.

Gythion, Greece

A sea of pastel-colored houses climbs the slopes of Mount Koumaros in this petite fishing town, once the port of ancient Sparta. Impressive ruins and stark countryside vistas draw visitors to nearby Mystras, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Corfu, Greece

Chronicled in Homer's *Odyssey* as a "beautiful and rich land," and arguably the setting of Shakespeare's *The Tempest*, Corfu offers a lush landscape of olive groves, wildflowers and white-sand beaches beneath emerald hills and mountains.

Dubrovnik, Croatia

Famed playwright George Bernard Shaw said, "Those who seek paradise on Earth should come to Dubrovnik." Known as the "Pearl of the Adriatic," Dubrovnik is an ancient walled city on the Dalmatian Coast that retains its centuries-long allure.

Ancona/Umbria, Italy

In addition to pristine beaches and stunning views, this enchanting port offers plenty of worthy attractions: café-line piazzas, Roman ruins and ornate cathedrals. Close by is Italy's lush green heart, Umbria, a region of incredible beauty with classic hillside towns, rolling hills and wildflower-dotted meadows.

Venice, Italy

Captivating and magical, with graceful gondolas, marvelously aging plaster walls and flowering window boxes, Venice is a city to lose yourself in.
