

URMIA Membership Categories and Fees for 2026

Voting Member

Member organizations must designate one "Voting Member." When requested, this person will cast a vote on behalf of the entire organization. Additional administrative duties include serving as the billing contact, updating the organization's profile, and assigning individuals as "Members" under the organization's membership umbrella.

Additional Individuals with Member Benefits

Organizational memberships include a set number of individual Members based on the size of the organization. Other than the designated Voting Member, Members have no voting privileges. Voting Members may add Additional Members under the organization's membership for an extra fee per person per year.

Tier 4	Institutions of higher education with enrollment between 4,000 and 14,000 students	4	\$800	\$200
Tier 6	Institutions of higher education with enrollment higher than 14,000 students	6	\$1,200	\$200
System	System membership is defined as one of the following: - A singular governing body operating 2 or more educational institutions in multiple locations (university system offices, multiple campus institutions) - An organizational structure providing risk management/insurance services to multiple institutions (consortium, state/government agency, educational districts) Dues amount equals the number of individual members under the System's membership with a minimum of 6 individual members and as many additional members beyond 6 as desired with payment of additional member fees	6 / 10 / 20	\$1,200 / \$2,000 / \$4,000	\$200

Level 1	Businesses and organizations that are attuned to the needs and purposes of higher education risk management professionals with a yearly higher-education revenue less than \$250,000	1	\$654	\$340
Level 4	Businesses and organizations that are attuned to the needs and purposes of higher education risk management professionals with a yearly higher-education revenue of \$250,000 or more	4	\$1,349	\$340

Dues are determined using data from IPEDS for US institutions and PSIS for Canadian institutions. Dues are non-refundable. Dues will be prorated if an organization joins after January 1 and has not been a member within the previous three years.

Retiree*	An individual retired from full-time employment in higher education and the risk management profession who was an active member at the time of retirement and/or is an Emeritus Award recipient	\$0
Student*	An individual considered a "full-time student" by the college/university attending; verification of enrollment status required	\$0
