

URMIA Membership Categories and Fees for 2021

Voting Member

Member Organizations must designate one "Voting Member". When requested, this person will cast a vote on behalf of the entire organization. Additional administrative duties include serving as the billing contact, updating the organization's profile, and assigning individuals as "Members" under the organization's membership umbrella.

Additional Individuals with Member Benefits

Organizational Memberships include a set number of individual Members based on the size of the organization. Other than the designated Voting Member, Members have no voting privileges. Voting Members may add additional Members under the organization's membership for an extra fee per person per year.
