YOU! The URMIA SCIP program offers a cost-effective, easy way for your campus facility users to get the insurance they need.

- *Does your college or university permit sports camps to use your facilities?*
- *Have you received complaints that they are having difficulty obtaining adequate, affordable sports camp insurance?*

How Does SCIP Work?

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All URMIA members may participate.

In order for an institution's facility users to access SCIP, the institution must first be an URMIA member. To see if your school is a member go to www.urmia.org/memberorgsar. Learn how to become a member at www.urmia.org or call 812-727-7130.

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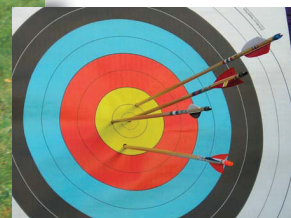
Sports camps purchase insurance online.

Refer the sports camps using your facilities to the SCIP website to purchase insurance: ucamps.rpsins.com.

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Receive a copy of the event coverage.

Upon completion of the transaction, the sports camp will receive a copy of the sports camp coverage and will be issued an additional insured certificate for the URMIA facility for forwarding.



What is SCIP?

The URMIA Sports Camp Insurance Program provides low-cost, best-in-class sports-specific insurance to the sports camps using your facilities, and you receive an additional insured certificate naming your college or university as an additional insured.

Coverages, Limits, and Important Information

What coverages and limits are available?

- \$2,000,000 General Liability Occurrence with Participant Legal Liability
- \$1,000,000 Sexual Abuse/Molestation Liability
- Full Coverage included for Concussion/Head Injury Liability
- \$3,000,000 Aggregate Limit per Location
- Option to purchase \$1,000,000 Hired/Non-Owned Auto Liability
- \$100,000 Excess Accident Insurance
- Very affordable cost for broad coverage and high limits
- No cost for additional insured certificates to the college/university camp venue
- Supports URMIA and keeps dues low

What kinds of sports camps are automatically covered?

Archery, Badminton, Baseball, Basketball, Cheerleading (without stunts), Cross Country, Educational Camp, Fencing, Field Hockey, Flag Football, Non-Contact Football Conditioning, Golf, Handball, Hockey (Non-Checking), Lacrosse, Racquetball, Rowing, Squash, Soccer, Softball, Swimming (no diving), Tennis, Track and Field, Volleyball, Water Polo, Wrestling.

Sports that need additional underwriting/premium:

Cheerleading (with stunts), Tackle Football, Hockey with Checking, Diving, Rugby. Please contact aj_morgan@rpsins.com for information on how to cover these sports camps.

URMIA SCIP Frequently Asked Questions

What does the URMIA Sports Camp Liability Policy cover?

This policy protects the sports camp and its additional insured from lawsuits arising out of bodily injury or property damage (of others) as a result of the supervised sports camp activities.

What does the URMIA Sports Camp Accident Policy cover?

This policy provides coverage for medical expenses that a participant incurs as a result of camp activities. The policy provides up to \$100,000 in Accident Medical Expense protection, subject to a \$250 deductible. Treatment and medical expenses are covered for 52 weeks from the date of injury. This is a supplemental policy to help minimize the out of pocket expenses if there are injuries while participating in a sports camp insured by the URMIA Sports Camp Insurance Program.

What proof of coverage will the camp receive when they purchase URMIA Sports Camp Insurance?

The sports camp will receive a certificate of insurance for the camp, which will be sent via e-mail once an on-line application is successfully completed and payment is processed. The sports camp will request that the university or college host site be added as an additional insured at the time of purchase. The certificate will be forwarded to the URMIA member.

How expensive is coverage for SCIP?

Premiums are affordable and competitive when you consider the \$2,000,000 liability limit and the sports-specific coverages automatically built into the program. Minimum premiums range from \$100 for a one-day day camp to \$400 for a multi-day overnight camp.
