Nine days after the Oxford, MI massacre, a "National School Shooting Day" post went viral on TikTok resulting in a number of school closures and time-consuming investigations. Stressors of the pandemic, political divide, and civil unrest have undoubtedly taken their toll on the population's mental health, but social media has played the protagonist in exacerbating polarization and increasing tensions. In this session, we'll identify common planning traps that emerged during the pandemic, as well as tactics for overcoming them.
