USLAW Connect should be used for:

- Connecting with fellow USLAW member attorneys
 - You can email individual attorneys.
 - If you are a member of a particular USLAW practice group, you also can connect with and email questions to the entire practice group.
- Requesting information on experts
- Internal promotion of USLAW-hosted events like webinars, exchanges, Client Conferences, industry dinners and reception
- Seeking a referral for a client
- Seeking an introduction to a specific client
 - **PLEASE NOTE:** Please reach out to Roger Yaffe first. If Roger doesn't have a designated relationship attorney for that client, then you can send the request through Connect.
- Requesting co-sponsorship support of a client for a USLAW Client Conference
- Looking up contact details for any member attorney

- Access to registration links and event brochures for USLAW-hosted events

- Under the Lawyers Only tab, access to important USLAW member materials, including:
