**KENNY TRAPP NAMED 2019-20 DIVISION II GOLF PRIDE GRIPS
WGCA NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR**

CORAL SPRINGS, Florida (April 30, 2020) – The Women's Golf Coaches Association has announced that Kenny Trapp, head coach of the Dallas Baptist University Patriots, has been named the 2019-20 Golf Pride Grips WGCA National Coach of the Year for Division II women's collegiate golf.

Trapp recently completed his 15th season at Dallas Baptist University in 2019-20, finishing the shortened season with four consecutive tournament wins. The Patriots won six of the eight tournaments they competed in and finished in the top-three in all eight of them, tallying three individual wins along the way. The team's four WGCA All-American selections was the most of any Division II program.
