UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO CAPTURES 2021-22 WGCA ALL-SCHOLAR TEAM GPA AWARD

CORAL SPRINGS, Florida (July 20, 2022) – The University of New Mexico women's golf team has been named the recipient of the 2021-22 WGCA All-Scholar Team GPA Award. The award recognizes the women's collegiate golf program with the highest collective average team GPA which includes all the team's student-athletes for the 2021-22 season. New Mexico's 12 team members had an average GPA of 3.961.

Leading Division II was University of Indianapolis, as the team's eight members averaged a 3.945 GPA, while Benedictine University led Division III with a 3.866 average GPA. In NAIA, Mount Mercy University led the division with a GPA of 3.799, while South Mountain Community College topped the NJCAA with a 3.656 GPA.

The WGCA also announced the top 25 teams with the highest team GPA for Division I, Division II and Division III, as well as the top 10 teams for NAIA. They are as follows:
