Since those early days, WWCDA has expanded to 51 chapters throughout North America, Europe, Latin America, and Asia Pacific. Membership in these chapters consists of nearly 5,000 lawyers and other professionals in the practice of white collar defense.

Many of our members have previously served in government positions and in corporate roles. Notable members include former corporate General Counsels and Chief Compliance Officers, as well as former prosecutors and high ranking government officials.
