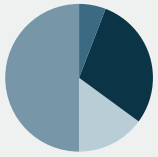
THE ASSOCIATION EXISTS TO PROVIDE:

WWCDA GOALS

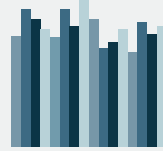
