CODING PARTIES FAQs



<u>Made with Code</u> (MwC) is partnering with the teen girl publication <u>Rookie magazine</u> to bring a coding experience to an audience that may not otherwise be exposed to coding. They want to amplify the effort by including YWCA girls into the experience!

When

The Rookie Magazine x MwC coding activity will kick off on September 24th. Your coding party will need to take place between **September 26th - October 26th**.

What local associations qualify?

All YWCAs are eligible to host a party. You do not need to currently offer a STEM/STEAM program. This is a great activity to incorporate into an afternoon of an existing program, but it is also an opportunity to try a ready-made STEM activity if you currently do not have a program.

What Google will provide?

- Directions on how to host the event
- Party kits which will include such things as: stickers, pins, t-shirts etc.
- Snack budget

What your local association needs to host a party?

A space, girls (ages 13-18), computers, an instructor(s), and a 1.5-2-hour window. The coding projects are extremely straightforward, no one should feel intimidated to host an event:)

Are there any requirements?

Share pictures of the coding party with YWCA. Utilize social media during the party. Acknowledge Google in any promotional materials.

How do I sign up?

<u>Complete the form</u> by **September 12th**. You will need to submit the following information: local association name, contact person, contact's email and phone, date of coding party, and number of coding party participants.
